What does it take to care for a child with a special need?

If it takes a village to raise a healthy child, what does it take to raise a child with a special need? In 2016, the Lucile Packard Foundation for Children's Health enlisted Deanne Fitzmaurice, a Pulitzer Prize-winning photographer, to find out. Deanne shadowed 10 California families who provide care for their children with special needs every day and every night. The children, aged 2 to 21, have diagnoses ranging from Type 1 diabetes to spina bifida to neurofibromatosis.
